HARVEST & WINEMAKING:

After the warm, dry summer 2019 was an amazing vintage with pristine fruit, small berries, and great concentration. Sourced from our Brookby Hill Vineyard, the fruit was hand harvested and had 24 hours skin contact before being lightly pressed. The cool fermentation was stopped when the sweetness and acidity were in perfect balance. The wine then rested on yeast lees for three months to gain texture and palate weight. The acidity, texture and minerality of this wine interplay harmoniously.

TASTING NOTES:

Aromas of mandarin peel, orange blossom and sherbet are mixed with subtle vanilla bean and white floral notes. The palate is delicate and pure with a slight quinine tonic type texture, releasing pithy citrus flavours of lemon curd and Cox's Orange. This thirst quenching Riesling has a delicious mouthfeel and nicely coats the mouth without being cloying.

An elegant aperitif and excellent with spicy Asian or Indian cuisine.
