

TERMS & CONDITIONS

This is an R18 event. Accepted forms of ID are valid passport, Current NZ Drivers Licence, Kiwi Access Card, Valid 18+ card.

A pre-purchased ticket is required for entry.

If the event is postponed due to Covid-19 or other reasoning, you will be given the option to either roll your ticket over to the postponement date of 29 January 2022 or receive a refund (minus booking and card fees). General admission tickets rollovers and refunds will be managed via Eventfinda and Corporate Packages will be managed via Black Cottage.

Corporate tent package: 10% non-refundable deposit required at time of booking. Remaining to be paid 14 days before the event. Packages are for a total amount per tent. Each tent is a package for no more than 10 people.

The serving and consumption of alcohol are subject to Liquor Licensing laws including the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and its requirements.

Entry to a live sports event and grounds at your own risk. Two Rivers Marlborough Ltd (event owners) take no responsibility for risk or injury.

Promotional photos and video will be taken at the festival and by purchasing a ticket and/or attending the festival you permit for these to be used.

The Event is an all-weather event and will take place rain, hail, or shine unless the event organisers determine otherwise at their absolute discretion. You should be prepared for all weather conditions. Due to the weather, cricket may or may not take place at the event.

All food and beverage for corporate VIP packages are to be consumed during the event times, none is to be taken off-site.

A dress code of smart attire applies to all areas of the event and will be enforced.

Corporate VIP tent clients, may, at their own cost, decorate their marquees internally on the afternoon before the event starts. Security, assembly, and pack down are the responsibility of the package purchaser. Pack down must be before midday of the Sunday following the event. No damage to the marquee is allowed.
