Harvest & Winemaking notes:

Sourced from the Southern Valleys, this pinot noir went through fermentation in open top fermenters, with 20% whole bunch and was hand plunged. This brought out the perfumed berry fruit as well as increased the silky mouthfeel of the wine. Aging for 11 months occurred with a mixture of oak, including 4,500 litre French oak cuves and barrels.

Winemaker: Sanna Stander

Tasting notes:

Deep garnet in colour, this wine is bright with perfumed florals, raspberries, blueberries and a hint of spice and savoury oak. The lively front palate flows through to a fruit-driven core of violets and cherries. A pinot noir with smooth tannins, great balance, and finesse.

Beautiful with rich game dishes.
